The Graphic Communications and Printing Program at Thaddeus Stevens College of Technology gives students a solid understanding of the creative and printing processes of the graphics industry. It prepares students to enter the field with a wide range of design and production skills.

The program's curriculum requires pencils, wrenches, sketch-pads, cameras, keyboard shortcuts, and buckets of ink. During their first year, students learn the fundamentals of print and design. Second-year students gain a deeper understanding of the industry and develop the skills required for their projected career path. In addition, students run the in-house print shop.

The program seeks to educate through experience using Adobe software, offset presses, a digital press for our in-house print facilities, screen printing presses, and other bindery and finishing equipment.
